

What's New for Project Management Center 7.2 Release

Project Management Center (PMC) 7.2 Release implements changes to the Base and BIL/IRA FARC, updates throughout the application to reflect the term “Notice of Funding Opportunity” rather than “Funding Opportunity Announcement”, and a new “Get Support” feature for submitting help desk requests.

Specific Functionality

BIL / IRA FARC – Changes

- Throughout the FARC
 - Replaced Contracting Officer with Grants Officer.
 - Corrected broken link to Post-Award Reporting Forms on grants.gov.
 - Replaced non-Federal entity with recipient or subrecipient.
- Special Instructions: Trafficking in Persons
 - Mandatory new certification consistent with 2 CFR Appendix A Part 175.

- Scientific and Technical Reporting
 - Added new requirement that recipients must include an ORCID ID for reporting scientific and technical information to OSTI.

- Special Status Reports
 - Updated to align with the changes to the Transparency of Foreign Connections award term.

- Current and Pending Support
 - Replaced principal investigator (PI) or Program Director (PD), and senior/key personnel with covered individual per RTES.
 - Updated the certification to reference authorization as a covered individual, non-participation in a malign foreign talent recruitment program, optional (until May 2025) R&D completion of research security training and ORCID ID.
 - Updated language regarding the common form for current and pending support to be consistent with the Terms.

- Tangible Personal Property Report – Annual
 - Updated threshold from \$5,000 to \$10,000.
