

What's New for Project Management Center 6.7 Release

Project Management Center (PMC) 6.7 Release implements a new "Funding Authority" field to the EQ-2 Form.

Specific Functionality

Updated EQ-2 Form

- The EQ-2 form will include a new, required field: "Funding Authority" to help the NEPA team better track how awards are funded. One of the funding source options must be selected in order submit the EQ-2 form. Funding source options include:

Options	Description
Base	Base funding
BIL	Bipartisan Infrastructure Law
CDS/CDP	Congressional Directed Spending / Congressionally Directed Project
IRA	Inflation Reduction Act

If one of the funding source options is not selected when submitting the form, then an error message will prompt the user to select a Funding Authority.
